**NOTICE TO EXHIBITOR**

**The safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this show, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all exercises safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. FourOaksFarms Dog Show Services and/or The American Water Spaniel Club (AWSC) and/or agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations

**FourOaksFarms Show Services and/or the American Water Spaniel Club**

reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against FOF Show Services and/or the AWSC or any official thereof.

**All dogs must be on leash** at all times when on trial grounds except when in the competition ring. Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

**No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions** for its acceptance. No entries will be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORM.

**A Recording Fee of 50 cents** for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**No entry fee will be refunded** if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee or by the American Kennel Club. There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

**RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis. There will be no refund for duplicate entries. **CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS**

**Changes, additions or corrections** to the entry form must be made in writing or by email. No telephone changes will be accepted. Proof of transmission of email is not proof of receipt by the Show Secretary. Refunds of \$5.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing. An administrative fee of \$3.00 may be charged for cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show who at the time entries close, have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present

### SWEEPSTAKES REQUIREMENTS & CLASSIFICATION

Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the regular classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate your Sweepstakes Class with the age division in the space provided for Additional Class."

### SWEEPSTAKES CLASS PRIZE MONEY (PUPPY & VETERANS)

For all Sweepstakes, 35% of the entry fees will be retained by AWSC to cover expenses.

The balance in each class will be distributed as follows:

First:	40% of the balance of the entry fees for that class*
Second:	30%
Third:	20%
Fourth:	10%

\*Note prize moneys will be rounded to the nearest 25¢

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

**Stud Dog Class** – Will be for stud dogs and two of their get. Stud dogs must be entered in the stud dog class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of stud dog need not necessarily be owner of the get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the get. Although the merits of the stud dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the stud dog must be examined to determine if it has any condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

**Brood Bitch Class** – Will be for brood bitches and two of their produce. Brood Bitches must be entered in the brood bitch class and must be shown in the ring with their produce. Owner of brood bitch need not necessarily be owner of the produce. Produce only to be judged, based on the merits of the get. Although the brood bitch is not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the brood bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the breed. Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

**Brace Class**— The two dogs with identical ownership comprising a brace must be named at the time of entry, only a single entry fee for the brace class is required. If a dog which is to be part of a brace is not entered in a single-entry class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only" for a fee of \$15. In making entries for "Brace Class Only" full particulars must be given for each dog on individual regular entry forms. An entry for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for Additional Classes as "Brace Class." If more than one brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising EACH brace must be designated, Brace No 1, Brace No 2, etc.
